Lashing Cheat Sheet

Steps	Purpose	Type of Lashing			
		Round Lash Join poles to make them longer (e.g. flag pole)	Square Lash Used to join perpendicular poles (e.g. cross, ladder rung)	Shear Lash Used to hold Teepee poles together	Tripod Lash Similar to Shear but joining 3 poles (e.g. make tripod...duh)
Clove Hitch	Attach rope to pole				
Wrap	Binds poles together; Pull them tight when lashing				
Frap	Tightens lashing; *	n/a			
Clove Hitch	Finishes / Secures rope				
Picture	What does it look like when I'm done
